Description of Workcamp:

PROJECT: GIED takes an active role by initiating programs and activities that promote rich inter-cultural learning experiences in partnership with The Department of Education (DepEd), Negros Island Region and the Negros Oriental Provincial Government. The two projects are inspired to promote learning English language in a fun and non-formal way, showcase the Silliman University festival to promote preservation of history and culture as well as the organization of local youth camp for Negros Oriental youth. Philippines is regarded as one of the English speaking countries in Asia. With a number of English language schools established in the country catered for mostly South Korean and Japan nationals, GIED see it fitting to introduce a language camp in a local community setting at the most practical way with the most friendly and hospitable Filipino people.
