The project :

The town of Baden wishes to organise their third international workcamp; this year it will be a trilateral project (French-German-Spanish). The project is still about restauring maritime low walls along the sea. The town and the anchorage service launched a program of safeguarding and renovation of its naval heritage. Baden has got numerous maritime-walls at different places, which, with time and tides, have become more and more damaged, and are now deteriorated. This damage is made worse by the 'parking' of ships and the steaming of water on the masonry. Today, it is urgent to rebuild some parts of this walls with a specific technique of traditional masonry with big blocks of stone. After 2 workcamps on the Dreven cove and the Guern bay, you will be hosted on a new site : the feet in the sand of a small beach, the hands in stones and the mind in holidays in the gulf of Morbihan ! The town will warmly welcome you and show you the cultural richness of the region !

Works :

Taditional masonry to restaure oyster farming walls and stairs along the seashore.

PROJECT:

Ancient gallo-roman town, Duravel, previously named Diolindum, was founded by the Romans to be a military position on the strategic route from Bordeaux to Lyon. Many remains are still visible today despite destructions during the religious war of 1596. From this rich history, Duravel has preserved a heritage to discover: a roman church of the 11th century containing the relics of three mummified bodies of saints, a remarkable square crypt, one of the few pre-roman buildings in France, and the remains of the Saint-Avit chapel, listed as historic monuments, as well as old houses, mansions, capstans, wash-house, and especially a 160 meters rampart of the 13th century. You will work on a part of those buildings. Thanks to very good experiences during the last three years and due to very rich exchanges between the local population and the international volunteers in previous years, the town of Duravel is looking forward to hosting this years' workcamp and its volunteers.

WORK:

Supervised by a technical leader, you will participate to the restoration of the rampart, reassembling parts collapsed, sealing the set. Traditional masonry work.
